Religious Education Online
Early Years Resource

The purpose of this online Early Years resource is to provide guidance and support to educators.

In the early years, each child is invited to interact with an environment rich in learning opportunities that lay the foundations for later learning and the development of religious literacy.

Educators are encouraged to select, modify, or create learning experiences, assessment and reflection processes from the resource to develop a learner-centred, integrated Religious Education program.

The resource assists educators to create a learning environment that provides opportunities for children to:

- Wonder in God's presence and creation
- Explore God's creation
- Engage in human experiences that relate to religious concepts
- Engage in role-play that helps develop their religious awareness
- Recall and retell scripture stories
- See modelled how to relate with others in the way Jesus taught
- Be introduced to simple rituals and symbols.

The resource aligns teaching and learning pedagogy and practice to the vision for learning as outlined in The Early Years Learning Framework for Australia and The Western Australian Kindergarten Curriculum Guidelines (School Curriculum and Standards Authority).

Easter

The death and resurrection of Jesus is central to being Christian. The challenge of teaching children in term one about Lent and Easter is to ensure that they have been introduced to Jesus and the stories of his life before the events of Holy Week.

Teacher Background

Ideas for Wonder Questions

- I wonder how God gives things life?
- I wonder what it was like to know Jesus?
- I wonder how chickens know when it's time to hatch out of their eggs?
- I wonder how God loves us so much?

God in People and Creation

- Sort and classify living and non-living things.
- Observe hatching chickens.
- Observe and care for silkworms.
- Identify people of importance and explore ways to show love and care for these people.

Human Experiences of God

- Explore ways of caring and sharing with friends and family.
- Explore opportunities for persistence when something is challenging and new.
- From stories of the life of Jesus, wonder about the things he liked to do/eat, etc.

Knowing Jesus

See *Bible Stories* chapter for Wonder Questions related to the stories.

- Introduce Jesus through the stories of the Annunciation (p. 72), the Nativity (p. 72), and Jesus in the Temple (p. 73).
- Tell stories of Jesus teaching people how to care for others e.g. Jesus' Great Commandment (p. 74).
- Tell stories of Jesus as a healer e.g. Jesus heals a leper (p. 75), the blind man (p. 75), Zacchaeus (p. 74).
- Tell the story of Palm Sunday (p. 76), the Last Supper (p. 76), Jesus' death (p. 76). Note: at this age it is not appropriate to go into Jesus' death in graphic details, the Resurrection (p. 76).

Living Like Jesus

- Through the Bible stories in Knowing Jesus, introduce that Jesus is God's son.

- Introduce Jesus through the stories of the Annunciation (p. 72), the Nativity (p. 72), and Jesus in the Temple (p. 73).
- Tell stories of Jesus teaching people how to care for others e.g. Jesus' Great Commandment (p. 74).
- Tell stories of Jesus as a healer e.g. Jesus heals a leper (p. 75), the blind man (p. 75), Zacchaeus (p. 74).
- Tell the story of Palm Sunday (p. 76), the Last Supper (p. 76), Jesus' death (p. 76). Note: at this age it is not appropriate to tell the story of the Resurrection (p. 76).

Living Like Jesus

- Through the Bible stories in Knowing Jesus, introduce that Jesus is God's son.
- Introduce that Jesus came to tell people about God's love.
- Encourage children to share with, care for and help others as Jesus would.

- Introduce the Sign of the Cross (p. 19).
- Introduce the Paschal candle (p. 26).
- Introduce simple prayers of thanks to Jesus for loving us.

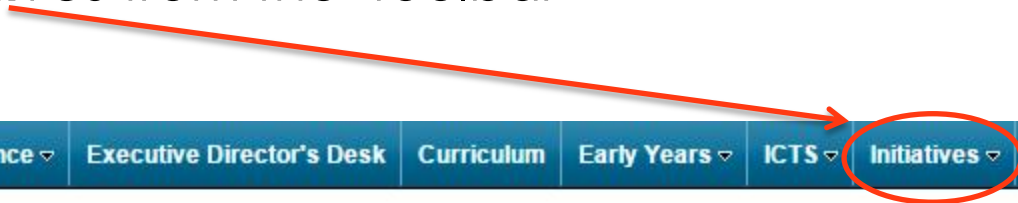



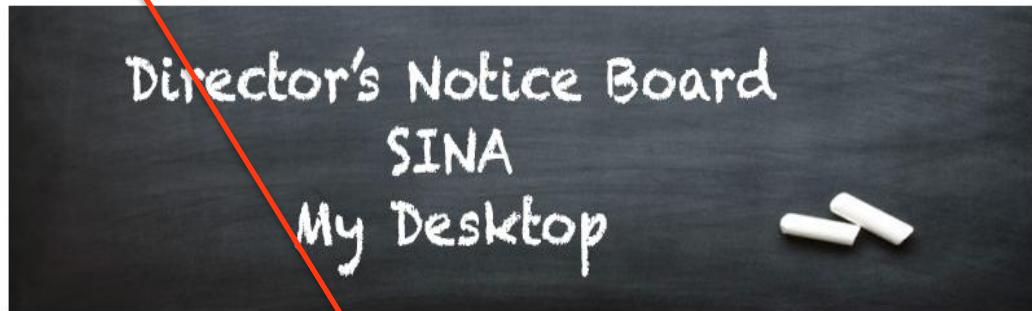
