

The Renewal of the Baptismal Promises

Priest: I now invite the candidates to stand.

Bishop: Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation: You received the light of Christ when you were baptized. On that day when you were welcomed into the Christian community, your parents or Godparents made promises for you. Now you are old enough to speak for yourselves, so today you have the opportunity of reaffirming your baptismal promises.

Bishop: Do you reject Satan and all his works and all his empty promises?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died and was buried, rose from the dead and is now seated at the right hand of the Father?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord the giver of life, who came to the apostles at Pentecost and who comes to you today/tonight in the sacrament of confirmation?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.



Holy Spirit


