- *Formal Prayer: Focus on a formal prayer for the week. Display words and focus on some each day. Use good literacy strategies to facilitate student understanding. Read and repeat/ parts for classes/ actions/ chant/ echo prayer
- *Informal Prayer: involve the children in praying, relating to Gospel theme if possible. <u>Use theme to make</u>
 Prayers of the Faithful/ Prayer litanies/ penitential rites
- <u>Prayer space and time: create atmosphere of gathering and sacred space: class prayer table/ focus objects or pictures/candle/readiness-centring.</u>
