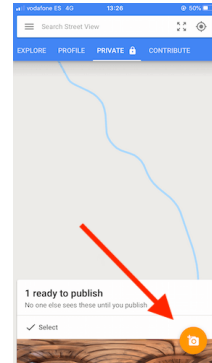
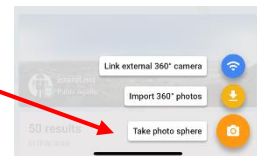


## 360 Degree Image Creation

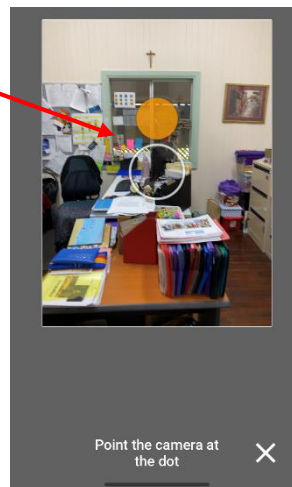
1. Download Google Street View from the Apple App Store (<https://apps.apple.com/au/app/google-street-view/id904418768>) or from Google Play ([https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.google.android.street&hl=en\\_AU](https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.google.android.street&hl=en_AU)).
2. Once you have the app you can either follow the Youtube video at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZyxWK5JTykY> or follow the written directions below.
3. Open the app and click on the orange camera icon in the bottom left of the screen.



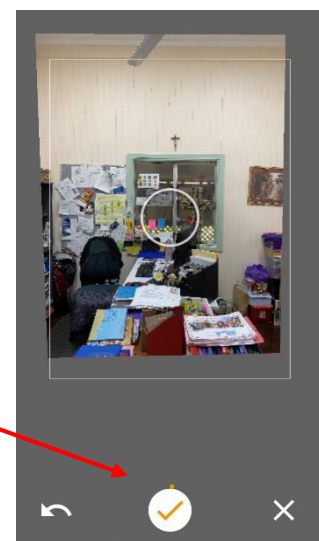
4. You will then have 3 options. Click on the "Take photo sphere" icon at the bottom and then give the app access to your camera.



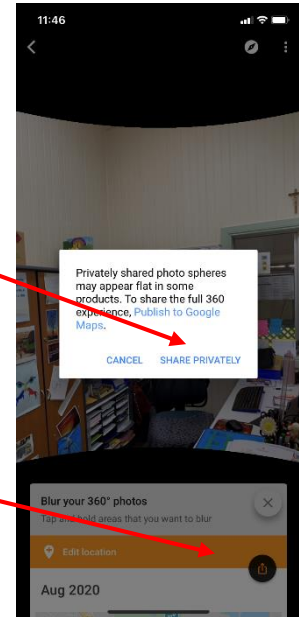
5. Then simply line the orange dot up to the central circle and your phone will take the photo.



6. Move gently left and right, up and down (if you want the ceiling and floors) and follow the orange dot and line it up in the centre circle to take multiple photos of the space. When you have finished taking the photos, click on the centre tick icon.



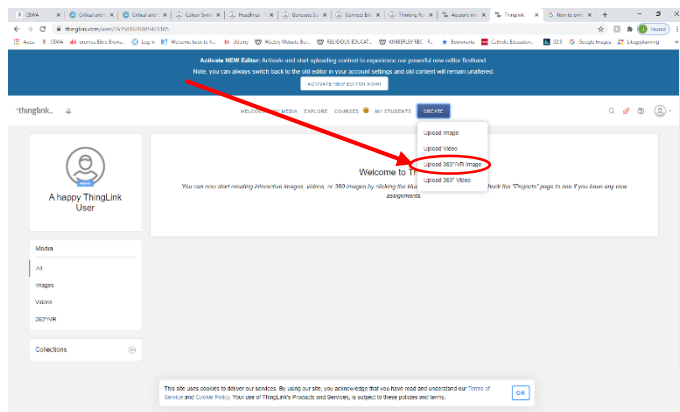
7. The app will show your photos put together to make a 3D photo, so you can scroll around with your finger and move around the space. Then Click on the “share” icon in the bottom right-hand corner and share the image privately.



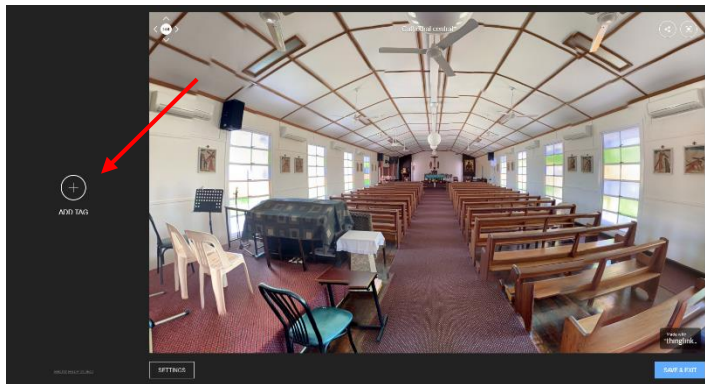
8. Send the image to yourself via email. We will use this image in our session on ThingLink, so please ensure you have access to it for the day.

## ThingLink 3D

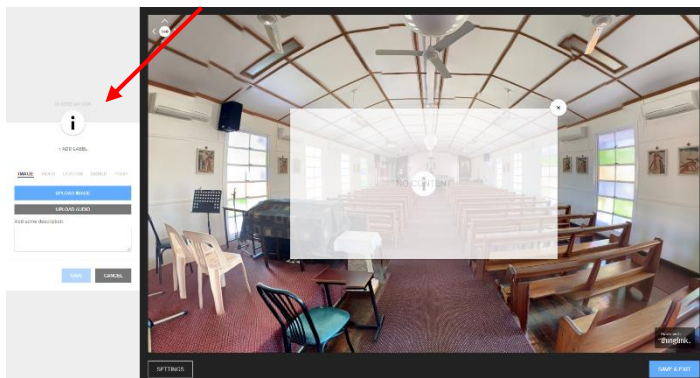

2. Go to ThingLink on a desktop computer (360 images don't seem to work using the app on an iPad).
3. Sign up or log in.
4. Click 'Create' and select 'Upload 360/VR Image'.



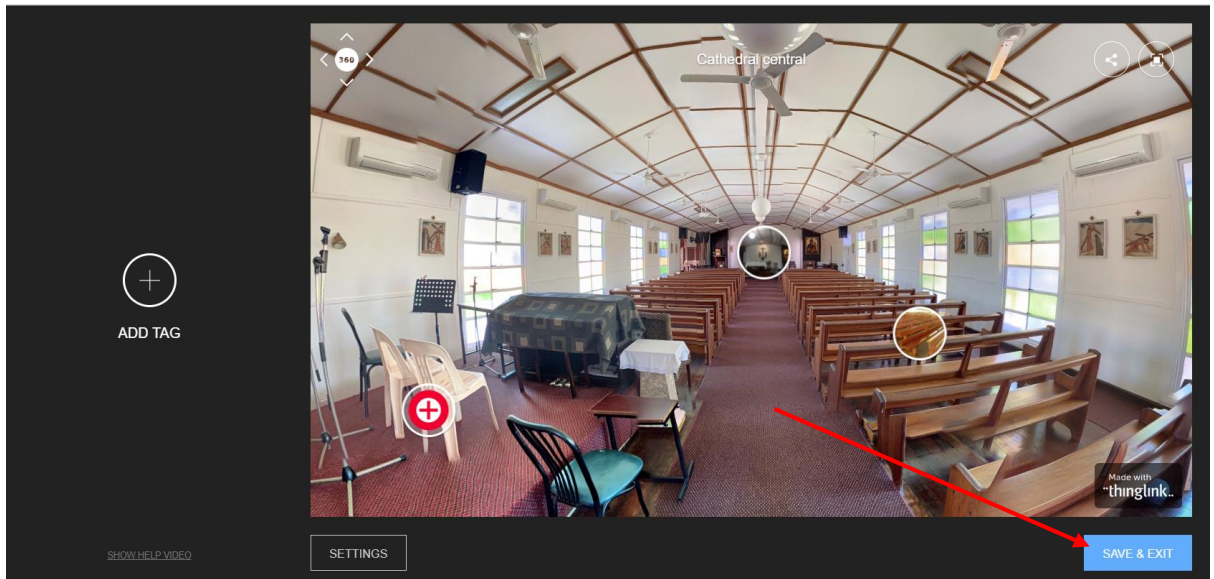
5. Upload the 360 image that was created using Google Street View.
6. Click 'Add Tag' to add various tags.



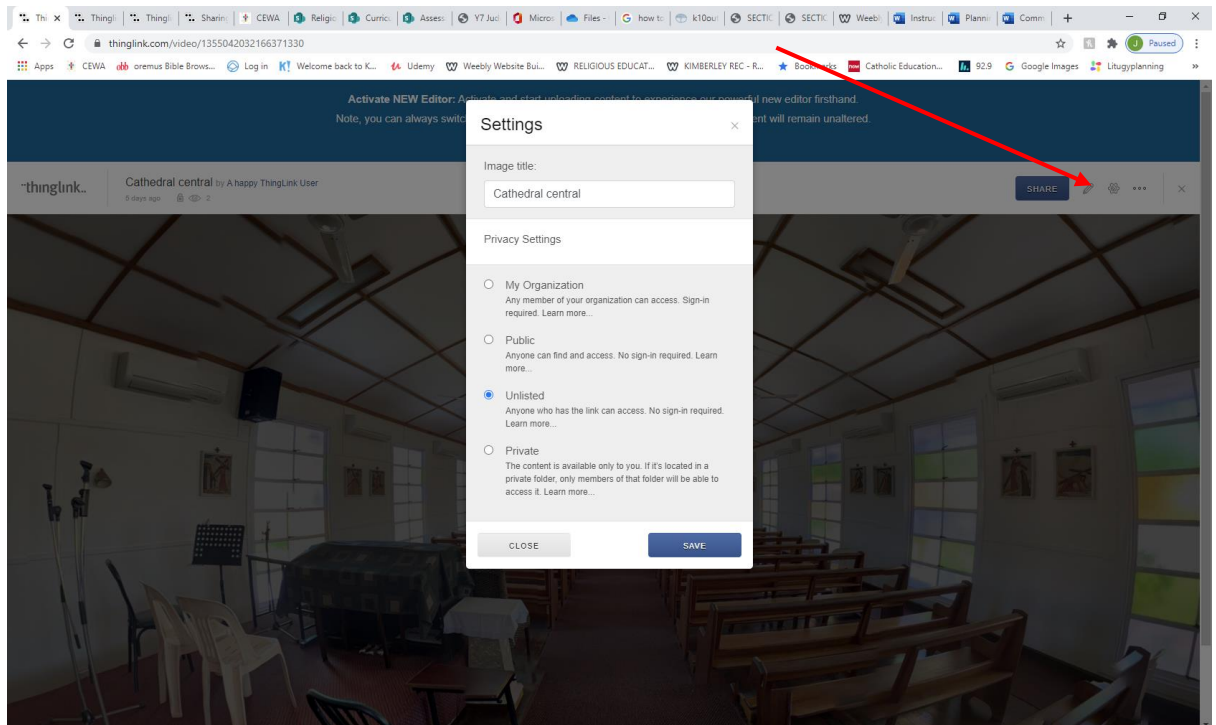
7. Choose an icon for the tag and/or add a label. Did you want to add an image, video or embed something? You can also click on tour to add another room's Thinglink to this one. You can also click on 'Upload Image' or 'Upload Audio' and add some text. Press save.



8. Click on the new tag which will be in the centre of the picture and move it to where you need it.
9. Always make sure you press 'Save' when you create something and when you are finishing a session, ensure that you click on 'Save and Exit'.



10. Once completed, make sure that sharing settings have permissions so that others can view it. Mine are 'unlisted' but it could be public or restricted access too if preferred. To do this, click on the 'settings' icon in the top right hand corner) and choose the privacy setting you'd like and click on 'save'.



11. Then to share the link, click on the 'share' button and copy the 'share link'. I then paste that address into a QR code generator like <https://www.qrstuff.com/> which will generate a QR code for the website which can be read by using your smartphone camera.
